Mayor Ferris called the meeting to order at 6:30 p.m.

071/18 YPUB	Dawe/Miller:	Moved that the Village of Ebenezer sign an agreement to have the Yorkville Public Utility Board supply potable water to Ebenezer.	Carried

Dave Schrader discussed his concerns regarding a contract with Yorkville Public Utility Board. He asked if there would be a plebiscite to give the residents a chance to express their preference. He would like the Village to continue searching for other water sources and suggested two possible wells. Did the Village consider purging the line from the well to the treatment plant? He wondered if it was possible to trace the aquifer supplying Mr. Janzen's well to see if it came anywhere near the Village. He wanted to know if the \$500 per house hookup fee would be charged directly to the users and what the charge would be for other houses to be connected in the future? He inquired if the base rate would still be charged if people had their water shut off for extended periods such as when being absent for several months. If the source of the uranium was the potash mines in the area, should that be a provincial responsibility?
